Dear Mr. Raines:

You may remember me from years ago when I was a student at Harvard living in Stoughton Hall while you were attending Harvard Law School.

I've written you now and again about my work for the past 27 years as a human rights activist for a constituency that is among the poorest and most disenfranchised in the United States, people diagnosed with mental disorders. I direct MindFreedom, uniting 100 grassroots groups and 10,000 members.

I am writing to you today because as a board member of Pfizer, Inc., you have legal and moral responsibility for the actions of that corporation.

Enclosed is a copy of a letter I have written to the FCC, FDA and FTC about Pfizer's deception of millions of people. I feel you ought to see this personally.

I look forward to your response as soon as possible. Because you yourself have been an activist, I hope you understand that we may need to start what is called a "secondary boycott and protest" of Fannie Mae itself if we do not receive a substantive reply.
