Dear Dr. Clary:

In our 9 Dec. 2003 letter to Pfizer, Inc. we requested evidence for your statement found in many TV and web ads that, "Zoloft is a medicine that helps correct the chemical imbalance of serotonin in the brain." In a 3 Feb. 2004 letter, Frank Raines on your board of directors assured us that you would address our concerns directly.

Your 17 Feb. 2004 letter does not address our concerns.

You were unable to supply even one citation to a peer-reviewed scientific article as evidence.

Our Scientific Panel has responded to you with the enclosed letter. If anything our Scientific Panel or I have said in our letters today is not correct we request that you send us evidence of that being the case within the next 30 days. My letter to you today serves as a letter of understanding, and please correct me if I am wrong, that you are unable to provide a citation to even one peer-reviewed scientific article as evidence.

We will also copy this to FCC, FDA and FTC to ask that they now issue a request that you halt use of the statement in question. We request that you not wait, and that you immediately end the use of the above-referenced, fraudulent, unsubstantiated phrase.
