Dear FCC, FDA & FTC:

Since 9 December 2003 we have filed repeated complaints with all three agencies about ads on television and the web for Zoloft by Pfizer, Inc. Our complaint:

The following language from their web site is similar to their TV ad, "Zoloft is a medicine that helps correct the chemical imbalance of serotonin in the brain." This is false.

Our Scientific Panel has engaged in a written debate this year with an official representative of Pfizer, Inc. about our concern. They have no evidence. Our latest response is enclosed. The whole debate is on our web site at www.MindFreedom.org.

Because the FCC, FDA and FTC have not taken actions to stop this fraud, we are asking for a Congressional investigation into undue influence by the pharmaceutical industry that may be discouraging you from taking the proper legal and moral action.
